Legislative Update – Tables on Estimated Apportionments Under MAP-21 and State-by-State Distribution

Following the recent passage of the Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century Act (MAP-21), we have heard from many APTA members who are interested in how the new law will shape funding for their agencies and states. The document linked below is an initial table intended to represent projected Federal Transit Administration (FTA) apportionments under the recently enacted surface transportation law. This is a “formula run” that was prepared for the congressional transportation authorizing committees by the FTA/DOT. This is only representative of funds apportioned to urbanized areas. While certainly NOT an official apportionment document or an exact prediction of what your urbanized area will receive, it may be helpful to you as you evaluate the future year funding impacts of the new law. The second linked table is an estimated state-by-state distribution of all FTA formula programs, along with an additional breakdown of other programs authorized by the bill.
