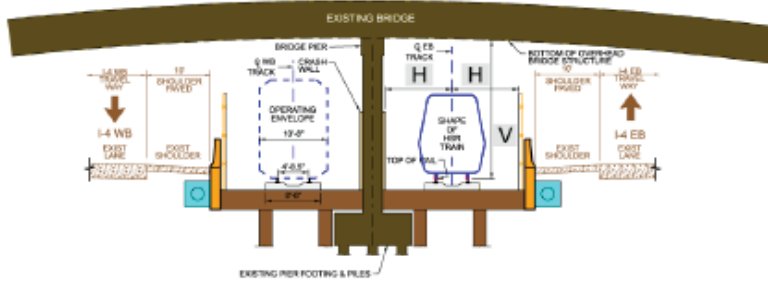

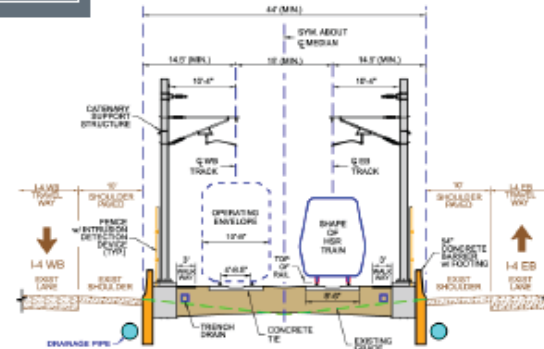

CLEARANCE DIAGRAM

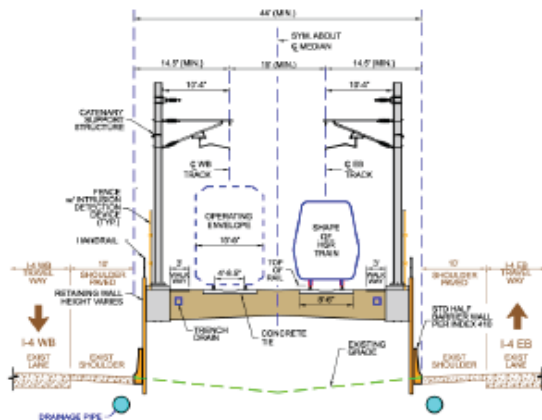

| >150 MPH          | 10' - 4" Min. | 23' Min. |

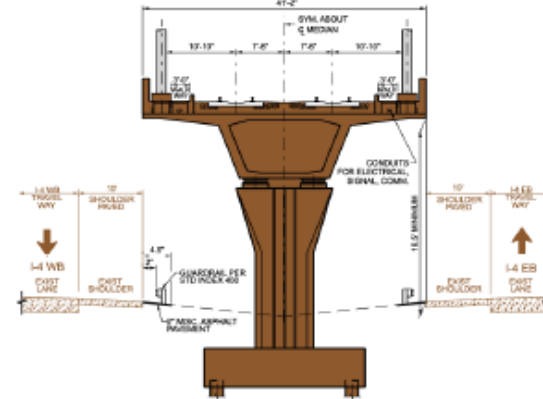
TIGHT SECTION IN I-4 MEDIAN



RETAINING WALL SECTION

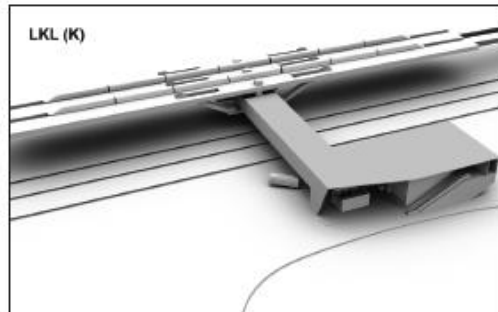
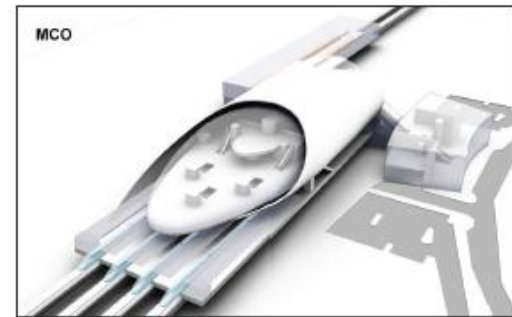
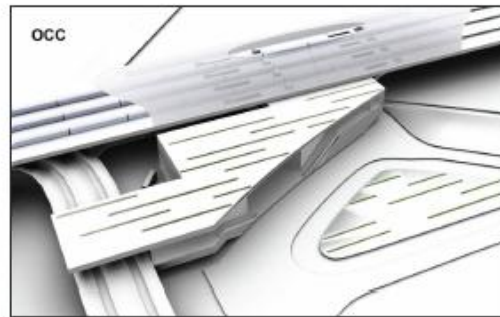
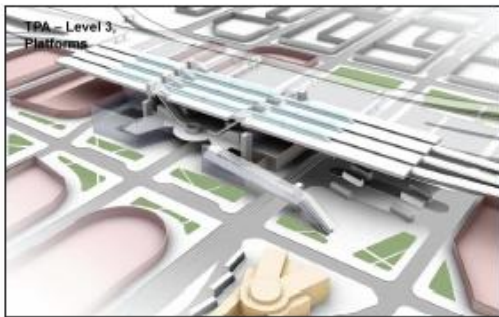
