

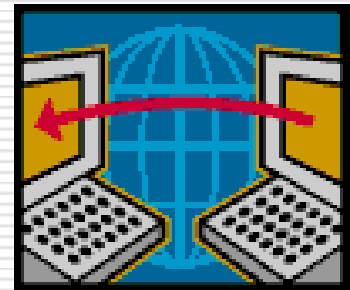

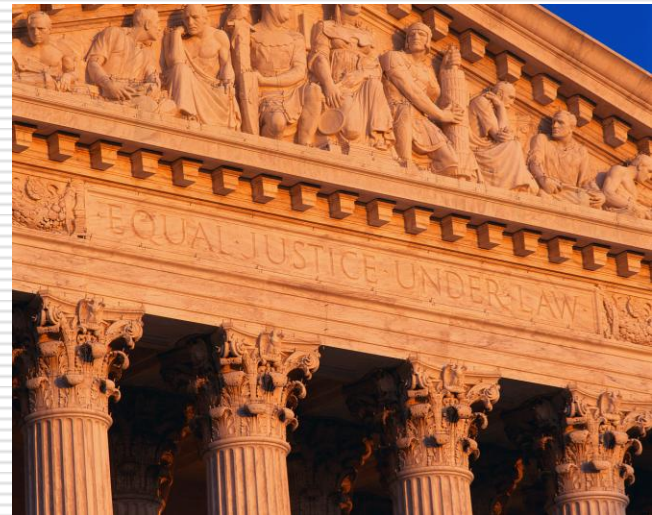

New Administration- Updated Priorities

□ National Dialogue –

- 2 Week Electronic Town Hall Meeting
- 6,800 visits from nearly 4,000 unique visitors
- Participants from over 1,200 cities and every state
- Almost 800 active participants (20%)
- 280 unique ideas with over 1000 comments

□ Issues Identified

- Strengthen coordinated planning process
 - Federal barriers to coordination persist
 - More opportunities for mobility management
 - Improve linkages to other governmental initiatives
