## New Rules to DBE Program

- Change and clarify DBE Program
- Additional accountability and transparency
  - Increase DBE participation and decrease fraud

- As a DBELO and a UCP Certification Official
  - “Level the education playing field”
  - Training, Workshop, Networking to raise the level of knowledge
    - Continued webinars from TCR on topics beneficial to FTA recipients
    - Consistency on regulations and complete official documents for the field



# USDOT's DBE Rule: Opportunities and Challenges

Operating Administration bank has to honor the resources check "lean and mean"
