Minming Wu is an attorney at the Office of the General Counsel of the San Francisco Bay Area Rapid Transit District (BART). Her practice includes general advice on Title VI and civil rights compliance, real estate and transit-oriented development, public contracting, and project finance. As one of the principal attorneys at BART on Title VI-related law, she has advised the agency in its successful effort to remedy Title VI compliance review issues, to develop its Limited English Proficiency assistance plan, and to comply with Title VI through dozens of fare and service changes and with environmental justice requirements for four major capital/extension projects. Ms. Wu currently serves as vice-chair for the Land Use and Zoning Committee of the American Bar Association's Section on Real Property. Prior to BART, Ms. Wu worked in an international law firm in Europe, clerked on the appellate level, and has translated professionally for both firms and courts. Before law, Ms. Wu was a project manager/land buyer and urban planner for five years for a real estate developer.
