APTA AND 85 COALITION PARTNERS URGE CONGRESS
TO PRESERVE TRANSPORTATION INVESTMENT
*July 30, 2026***

In three letters to Congress over the past 10 days, APTA, together with 85 Coalition partners, urged Congress to preserve FY 2026 transportation investment levels (including guaranteed funding from the Highway Trust Fund and advance appropriations) in any Continuing Resolution (CR) and Surface Transportation Authorization Extension Act. Without advance appropriations, public transit investment would be cut 20 percent. Passenger rail investment would be cut 83 percent and receive no guaranteed funding. Congress must enact a CR and Surface Transportation Extension Act by October 1.
