# SAN FRANCISCO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (SFO)


The San Francisco International Airport (SFO) is served by BART's Red and Yellow lines, depending on the timing of your arrival. For those arriving before 9 p.m., take a Yellow Line (San Francisco/Antioch) or Red Line (San Francisco/Richmond) train. Trains run every 3-9 minutes during this time. For those arriving between 9 p.m. to Midnight, take a Yellow Line (San Francisco/Antioch) train. Trains run every 20 minutes during this time.


The SFO BART Station is located on the Departures/Ticketing Level of the International Terminal (G Gates side). If you arrive at a Domestic terminal, BART is accessible by riding SFO's free AirTrain to the Garage G/BART Station stop.

### **Transit Passes:**

Saturday, June 28<sup>th</sup> and Sunday, June 29<sup>th</sup>, between the hours of 11:00 a.m. – 6:30 p.m., transit passes will be available for pick up, for those registered, at tables located just before entering BART's fare gates at SFO. See map below.

- International Terminal: Table will be to your right before entering the fare gates.
- **AirTrain Level:** Table will be on the opposite side of the fare gates (to your right after getting off the Air Train).





Once on BART's Yellow or Red line train, you will ride 10 stops, get off at Powell Street Station, and exit B3 Market & 4th St. The San Francisco Marriott Marquis is located on the east side of 4th Street, 1 block down the south of Market Street.

# Public Transportation Directions from OAK

# **OAKLAND INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (OAK)**

The Oakland International Airport (OAK) is served by BART to OAK Airport service which connects to BART's Green, Orange, and Blue lines. BART to OAK service runs every 9 minutes unless there is planned or unplanned maintenance and headways increase to 18 minutes.

Exit the OAK terminal and enter the BART station located across the crosswalk. You will take then take the 8-minute ride to BART's Coliseum station (no payment required until after the ride).

#### **Transit Passes:**


Saturday, June 28<sup>th</sup> and Sunday, June 29<sup>th</sup>, between the hours of 11:00 a.m. – 6:30 p.m., transit passes will be available to pick up, for those registered, at tables located just before entering BART's fare gates.

After you exit the fare gates, proceed down the escalator or elevator to the connecting Coliseum station platform. Take either the Green (SF/Daly City) or Blue (SF/Daly City) train on Platform 2 towards San Francisco. Trains arrive every 7-13 minutes until 7:30 p.m. and then every 20 minutes until 12:09 a.m.

Once on BART's Green or Blue line train, you will ride 6 stops, get off at Powell Street Station, and exit B3 Market & 4<sup>th</sup> St. The San Francisco Marriott Marquis is located on the east side of 4<sup>th</sup> Street, 1 block down the south of Market Street.
