- **Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design**
- **Proactive crime fighting technique**
- **Design and use of the built environment**
- **Leads to less fear and incidents of crime**
- **Improves quality of life**
- **Reduces the opportunity for crime**

- **Territorial Reinforcement**
- **Natural Access Control**

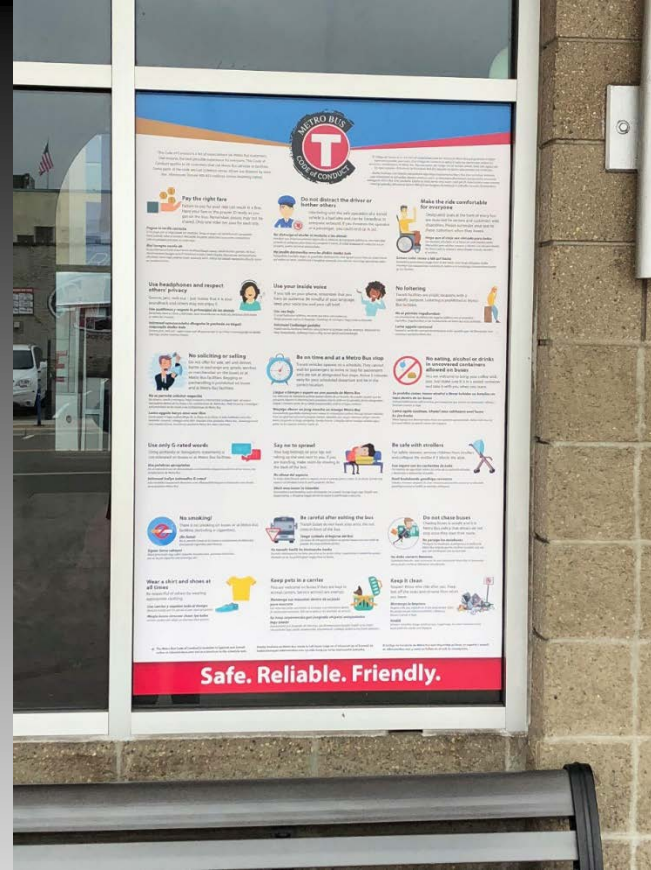
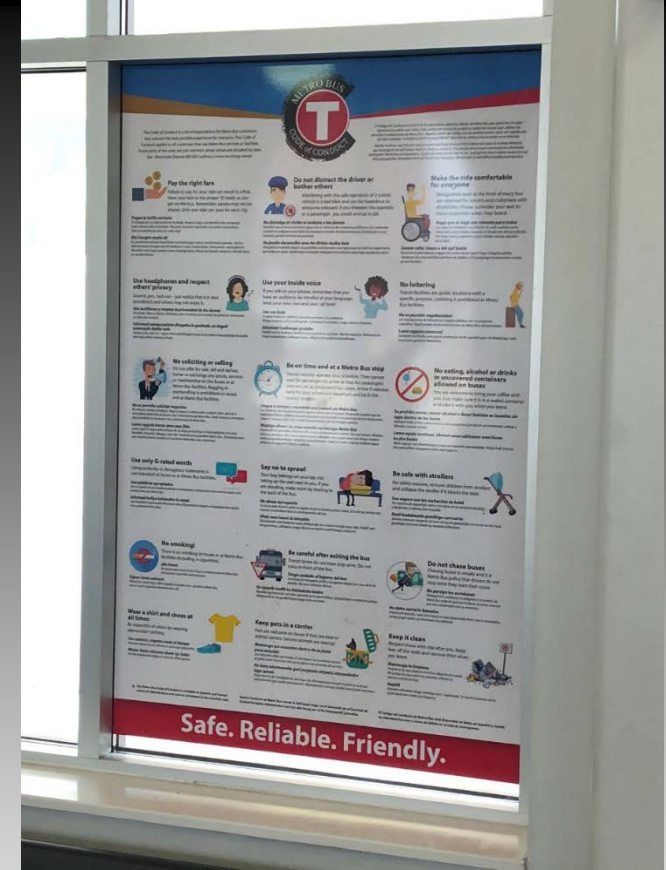

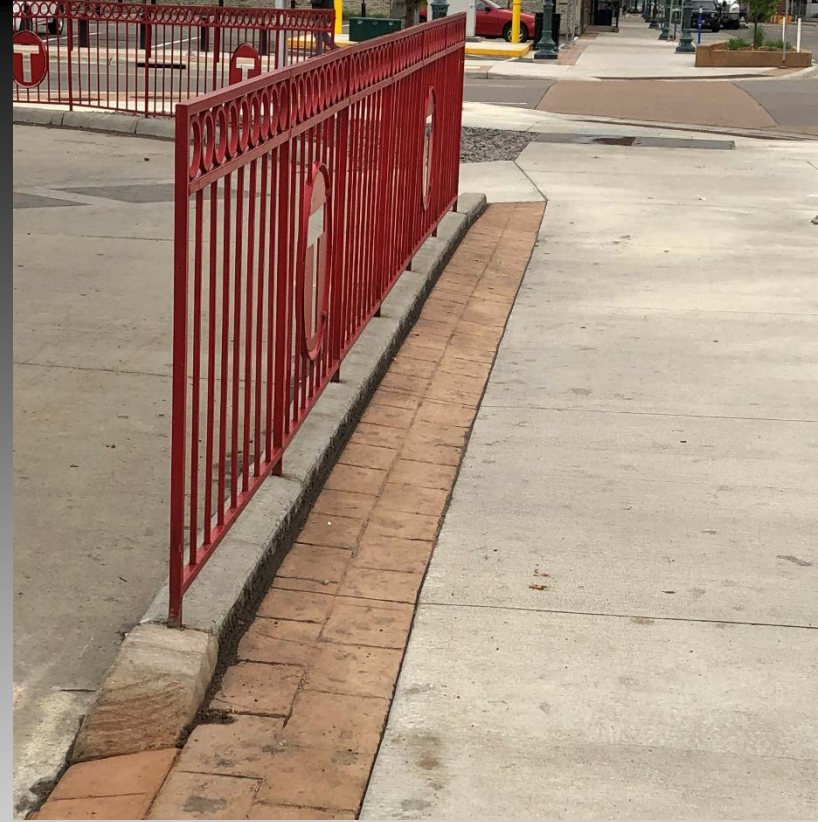
Improved Landscaping = Less Garbage/Loitering

October 2016-May 2017=124 Calls

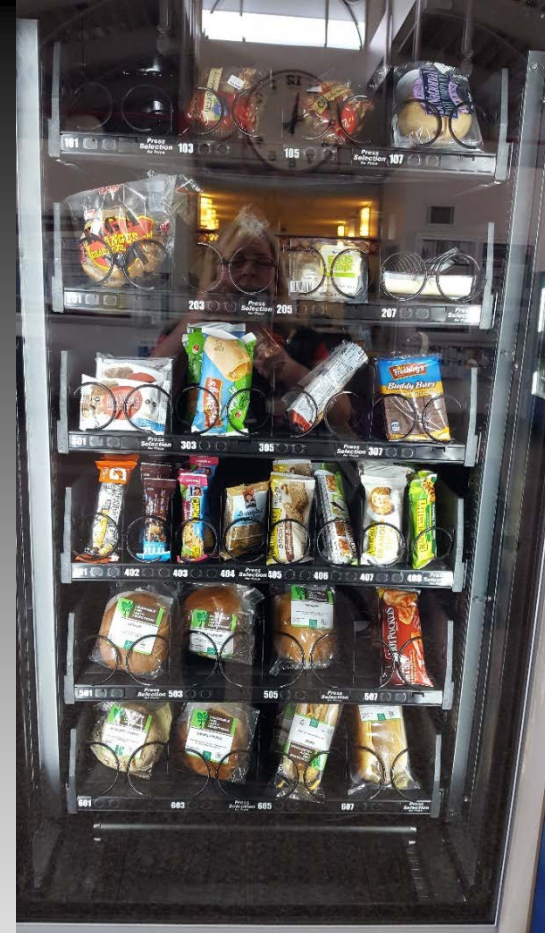
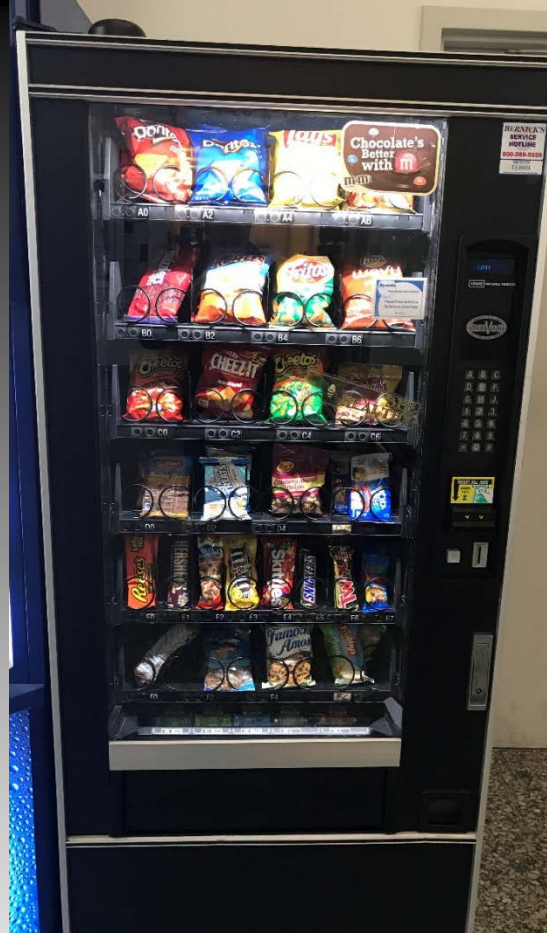
