Cycling investments in the 10-Year Vision



- Combined funding ~\$22M
- New and state-of-good-repair projects
- "TransLink owned bicycle infrastructure"
 - Bike parking
 - Regional cycling routes
- Cost-share with municipalities for bike infra upgrades (~\$54M)


Existing facilities

 - Compass accessible






T Future Bike Parkade Projects




Municipal Partnerships


Bicycle Infrastructure Capital Cost-Share Program (BICCS)

Major Road Network & Bike Investments (MRNB)

- Competitive processes
- Usually up to 50% cost-share
- Priority for low-stress routes
