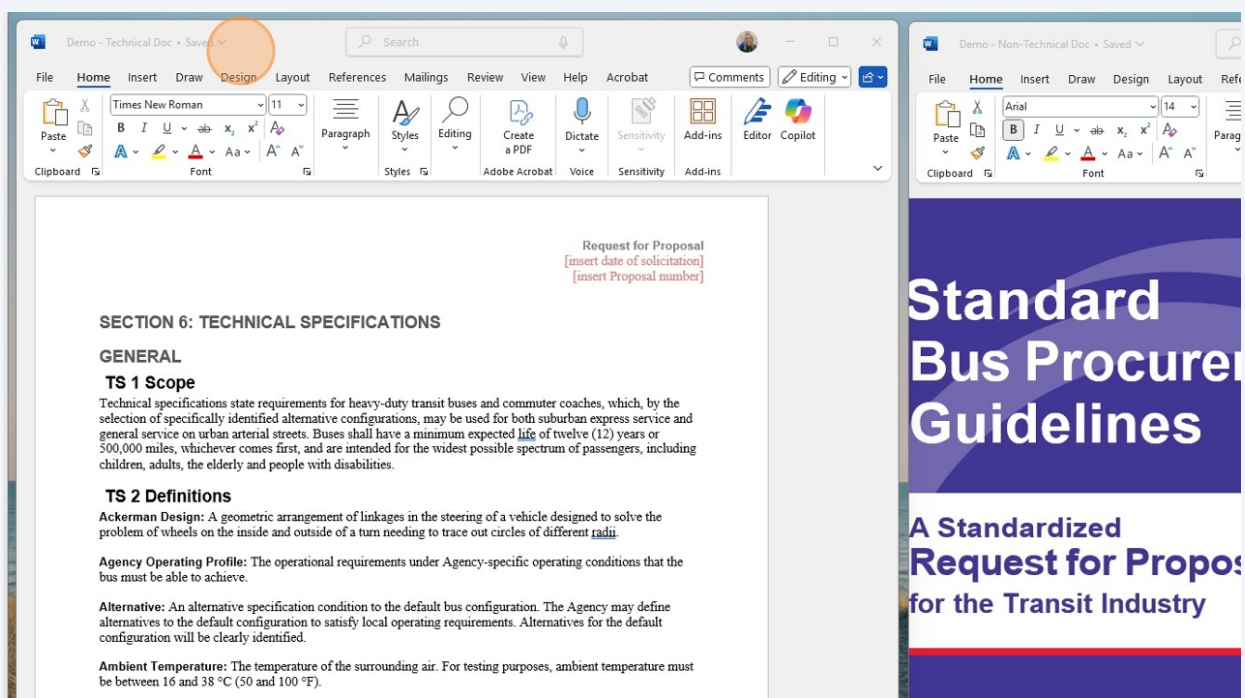

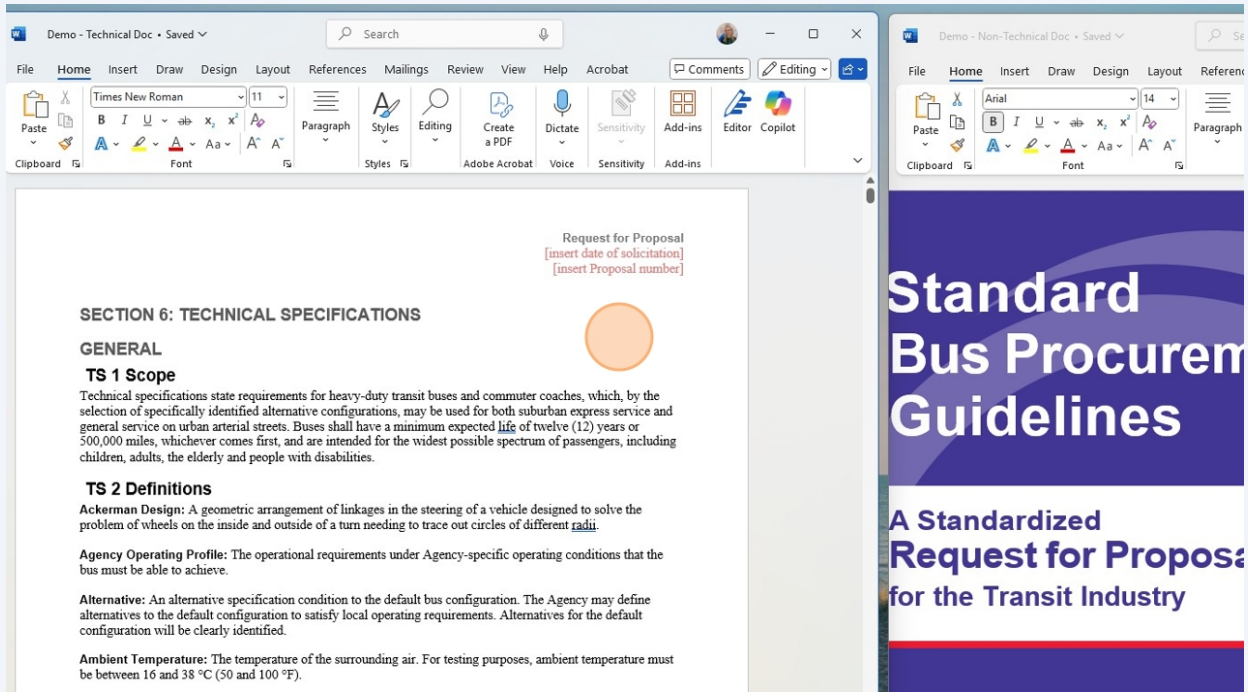
1 Welcome to the last part of the APTA automated White Book demo.

You should have completed both Excel input files (as shown in the Demo Part 1) and created your contract templates with mail merge (as shown in the Demo Part 2).



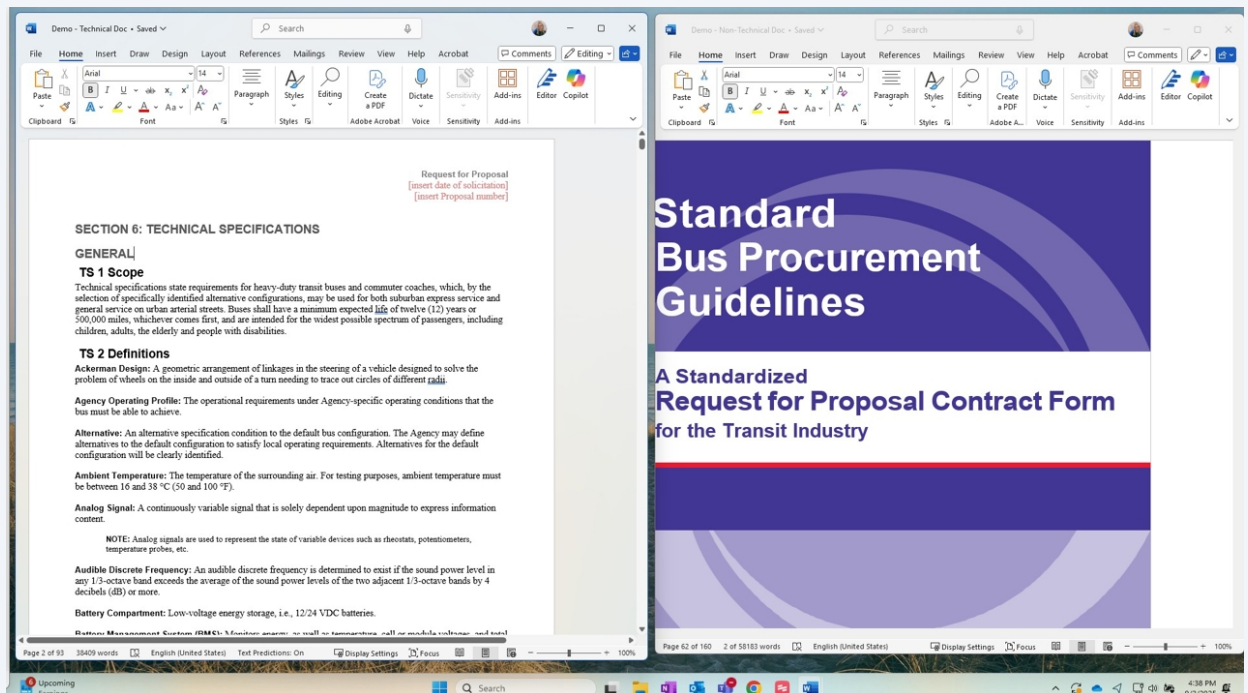

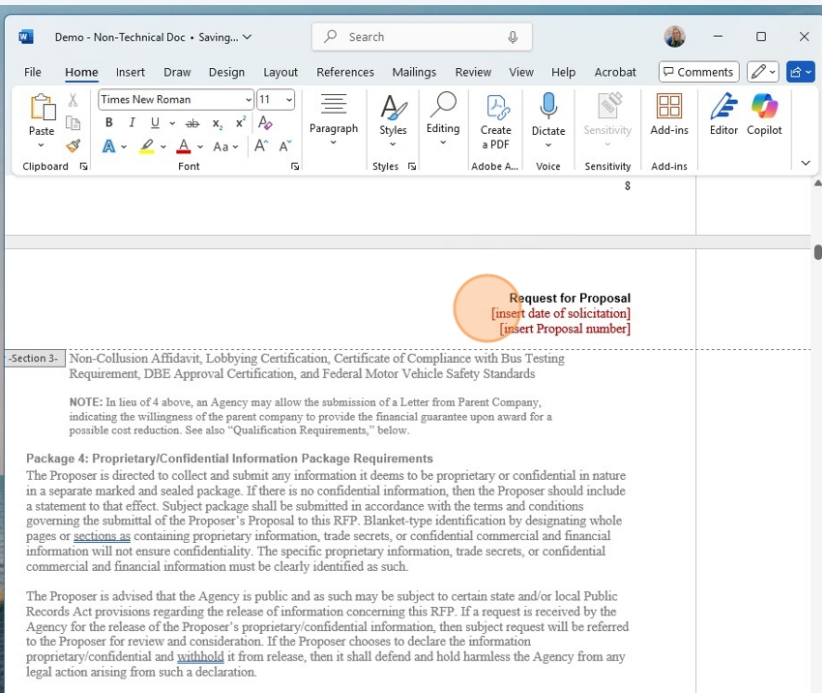
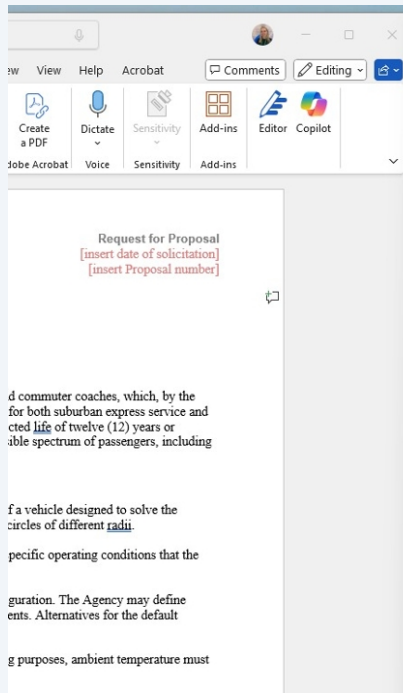
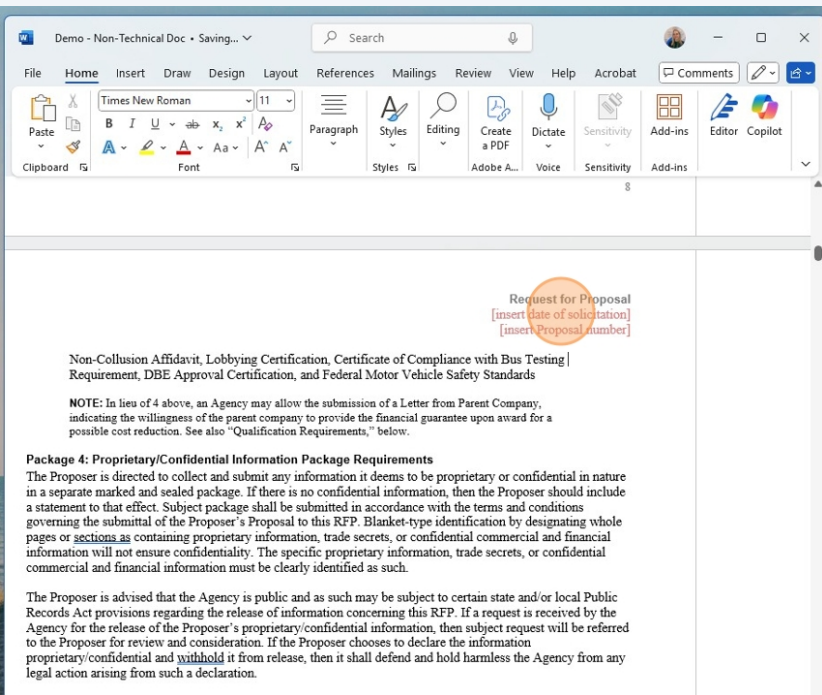
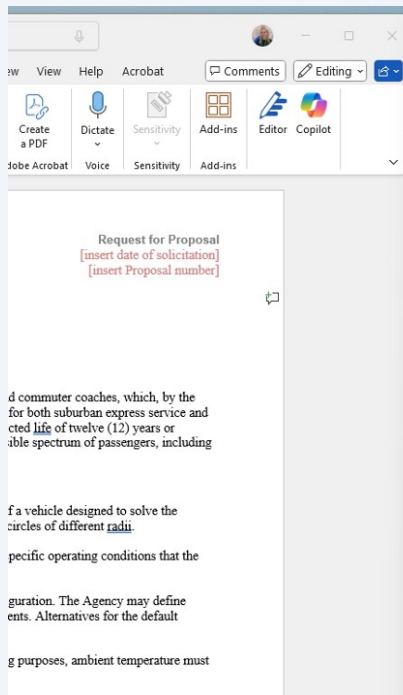
7 Next, review and finalize the document.

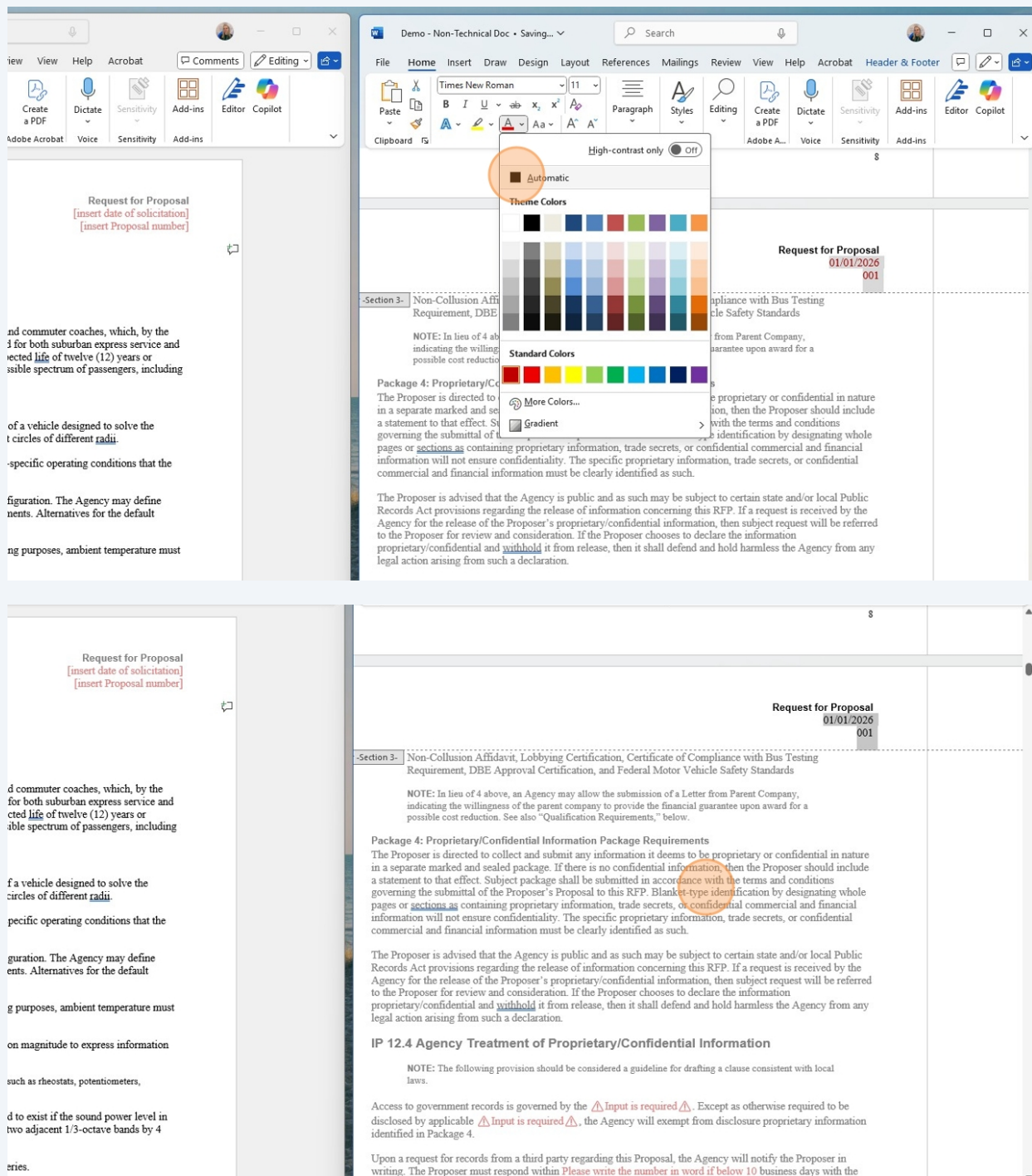
All content imported from Excel will appear in red font.

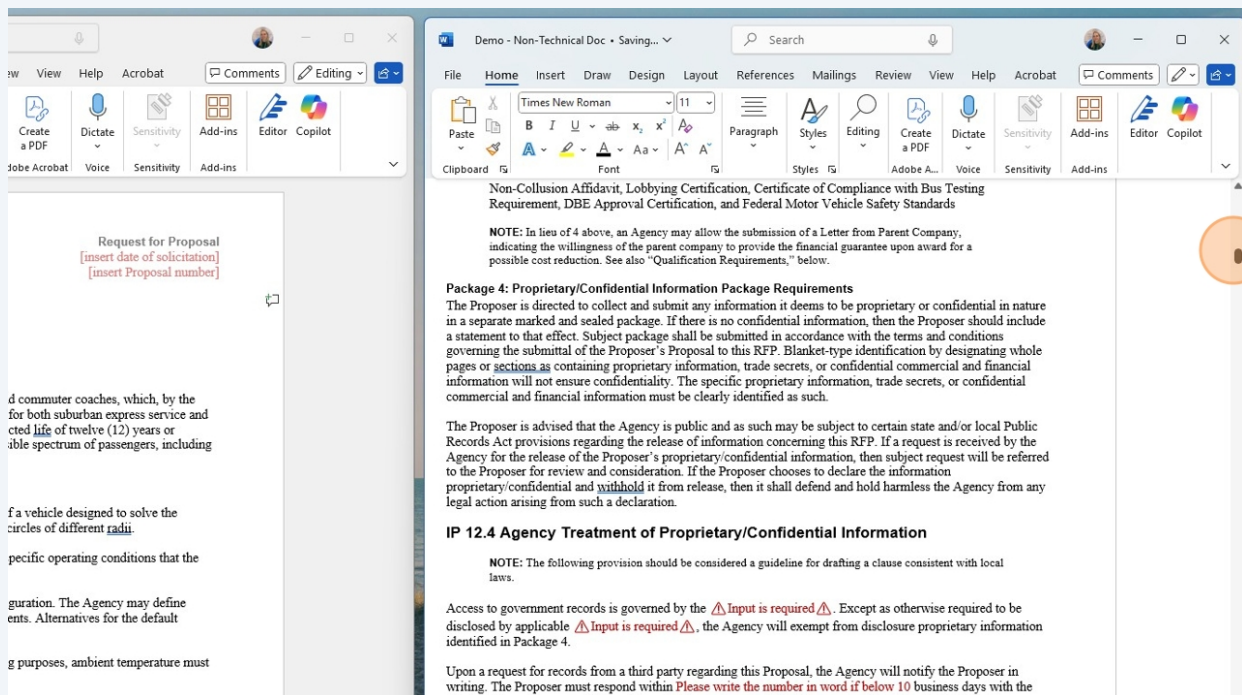
Review each red entry and change the font color to Automatic or black once confirmed.

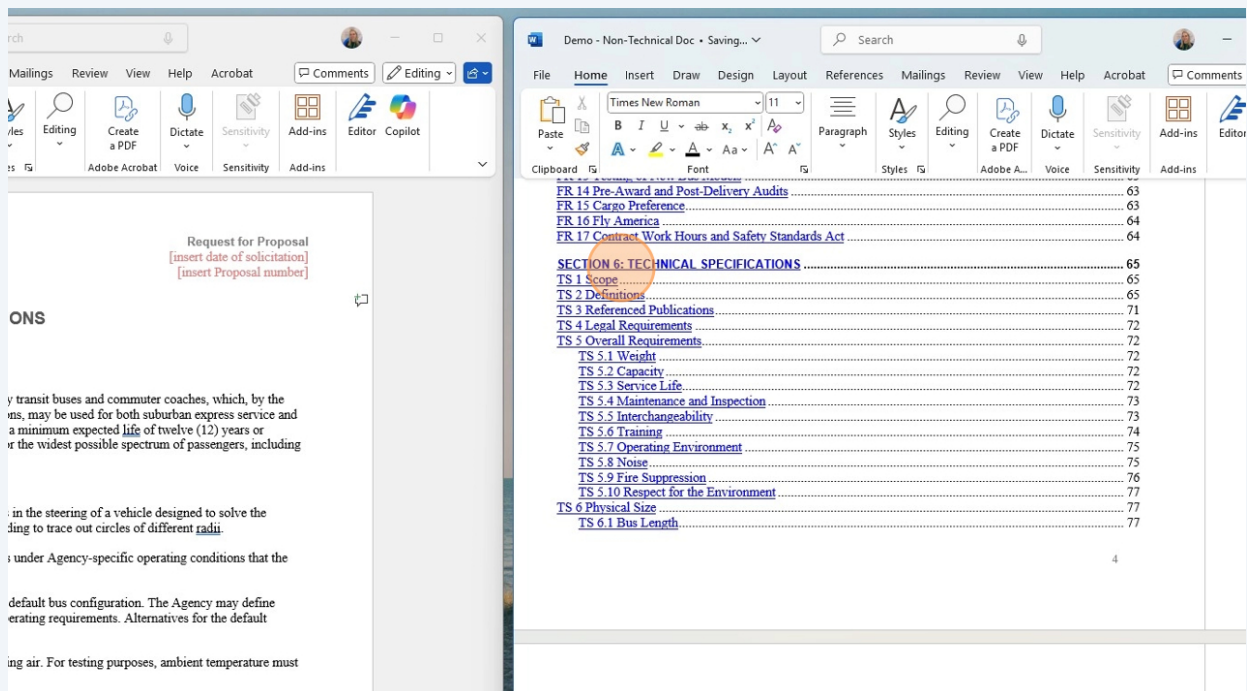
