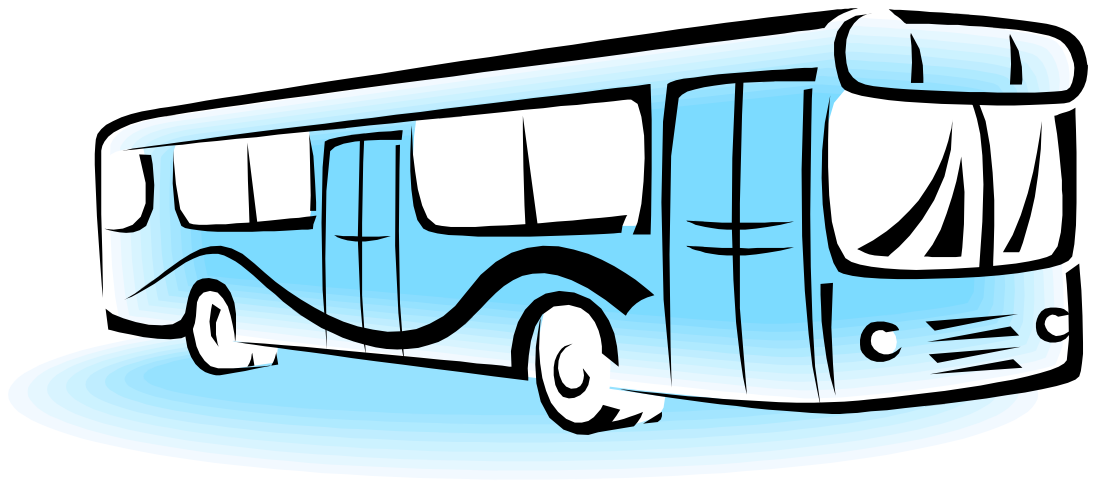

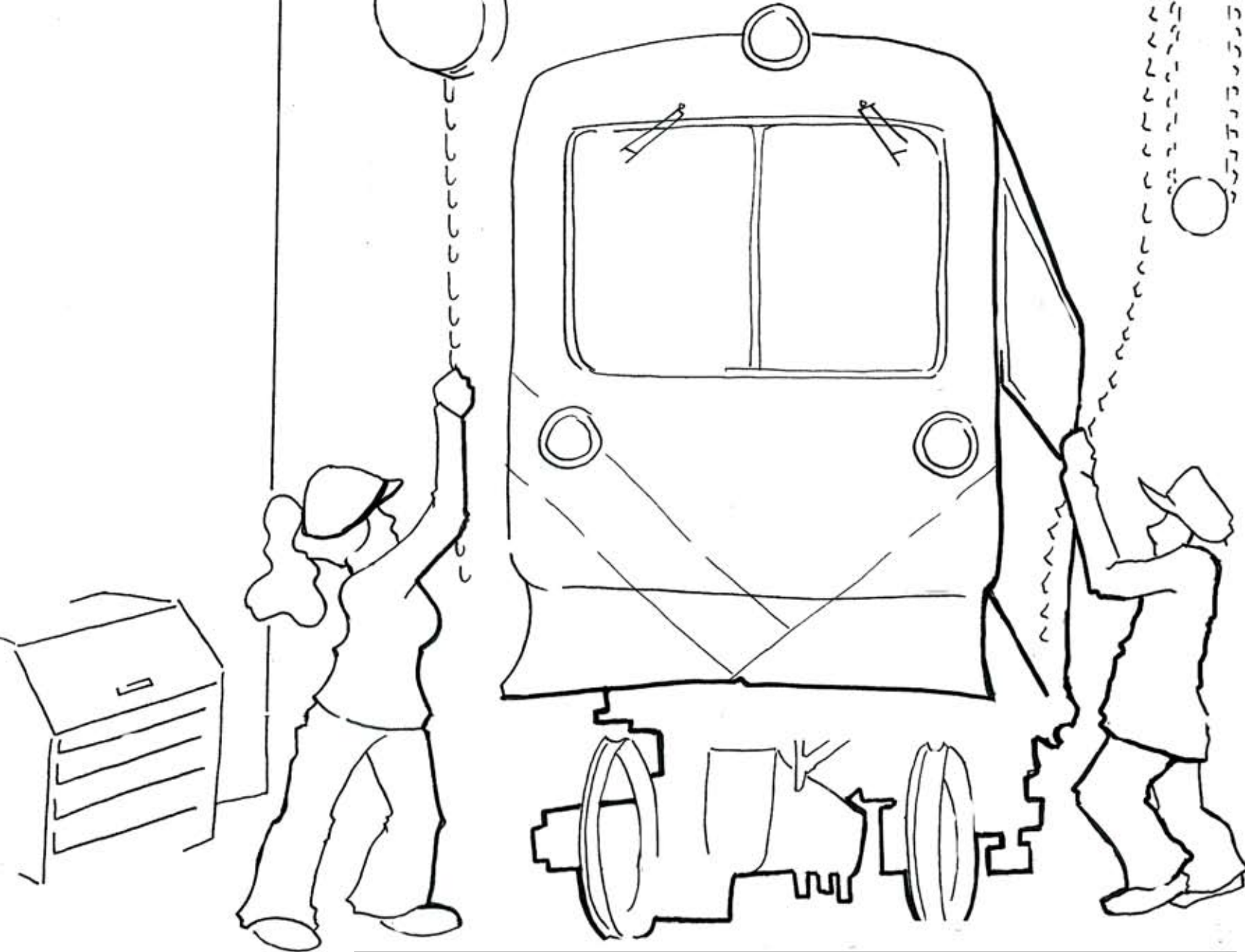




Bus drivers operate buses, communicate with passengers, and follow bus routes to provide safe transportation to passengers.

Accountants use math and computers every day to help transit companies keep track of money.

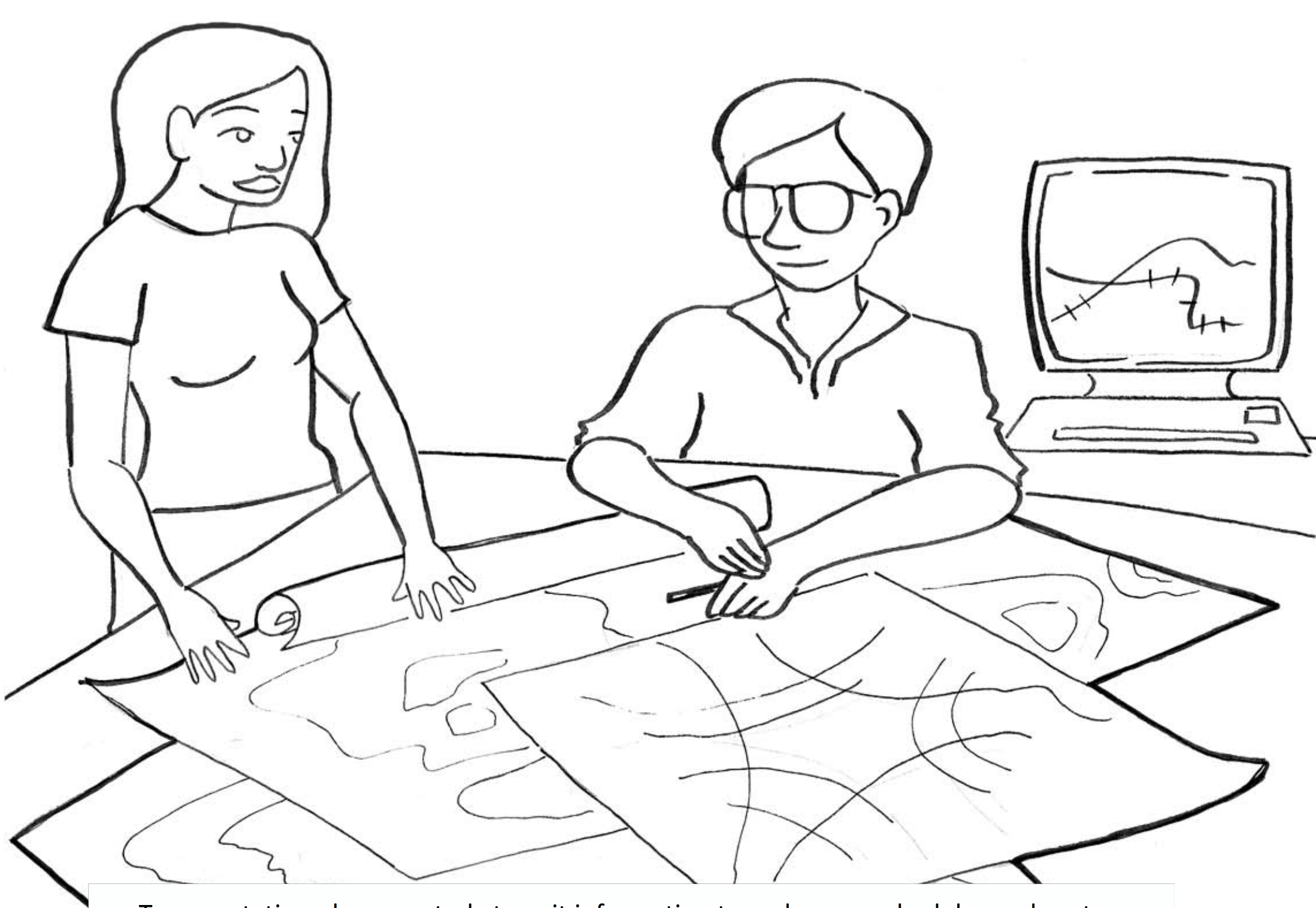


Dispatchers communicate with bus drivers to help solve problems and keep vehicles on schedule.
