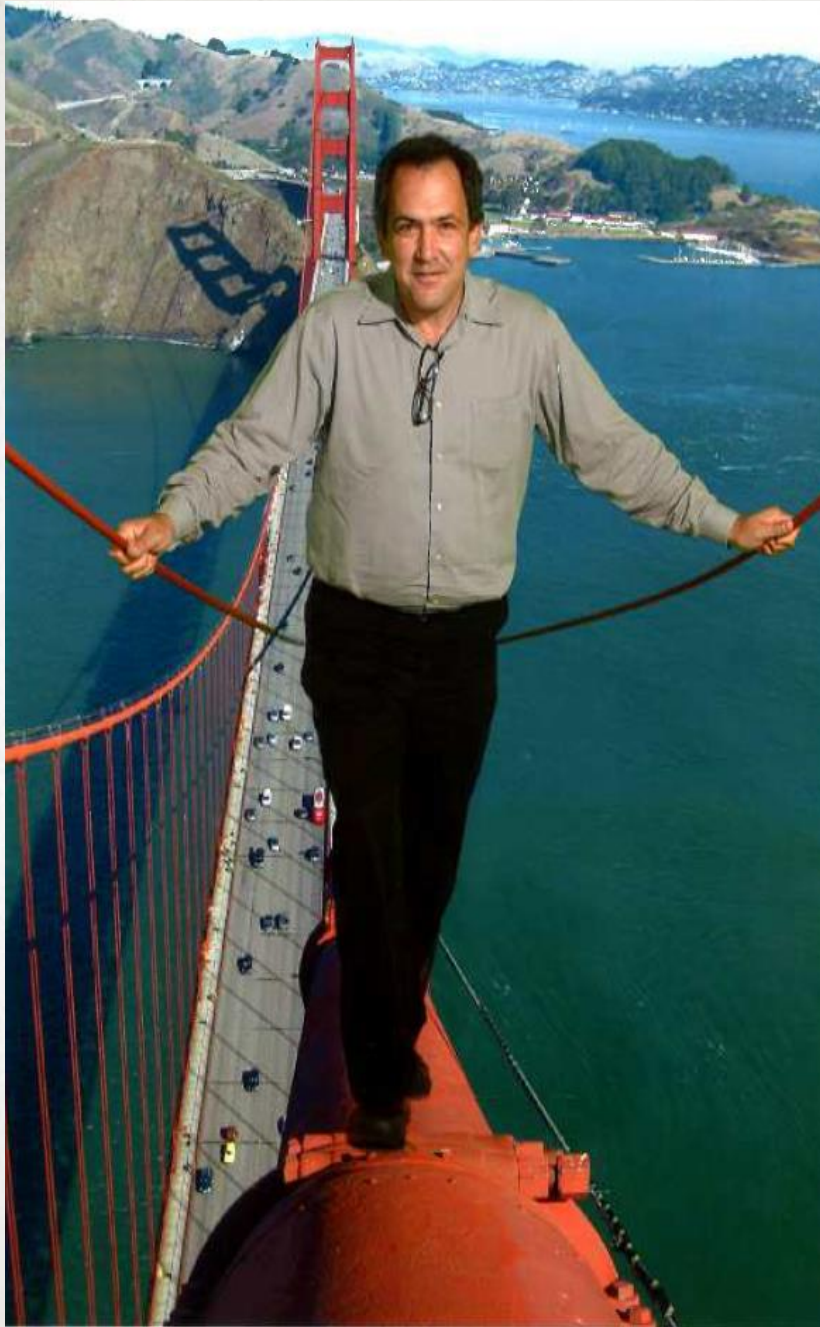

INTRODUCTION

21 In April, 2017, under the cover of night, two men, Peter C. Kurer and his
22 accomplice Thomas J. Rector, made an extraordinarily irresponsible decision that put
23 their own lives, and the lives of many others in the San Francisco Bay Area, in grave
24 danger, and profited from these actions.

25 Knowingly and recklessly disregarding both law and common sense, Kurer –
26 known by his modest social media following as "Peter Teatime" – climbed over 500 feet
27 to the top of the Golden Gate Bridge's North Tower, evading security measures along the
