HIGH-SPEED RAIL: A New Model For Infrastructure Delivery

- » Require Recycling Steel and Concrete from Demolition and Construction
- » Invest in Clean Agricultural Equipment to Offset Emissions
- » Require the Cleanest Equipment on Site

- » Also features section on environmental compliance management



A tool is only as good as its users

DEFINE AND REINFORCE DATA QUALITY

- User training is critical
- » But go beyond Usage 101 and define data quality



KNOW PEOPLE, NOT JUST THINGS

- Have good relationships with your primary data reviewers
- Know the contract, but also know someone who knows it better than you



NEW TOOLS TAKE TIME AND RESOURCES TO BUILD

- Have confidence in your reporting and QA/QC process
- Find the proper balance between sophistication and simplicity
- Listen to users



DATA-DRIVEN DECISION MAKING



- Ask questions to develop baselines and improve procurement, such as:
- » What kinds of technologies in off-road equipment can we target in future contracts to greatly reduce construction emissions?
- » What are the local standard specifications for recycled content of materials, and can we require more in future contracts?
- What is the local supply and availability of recycled content for materials, e.g., fly ash, other SCM for concrete, etc.?

FUTURE ENHANCEMENTS

- Expanding reporting features
- New modules
- Incorporate operations and utility tracking alongside capital projects
