City shall not be bound by the obligation to maintain the lanes and markings should it determine at any time, in its sole discretion, to move, change or discontinue use of the bicycle lanes. In no event shall the obligations under this Agreement run longer than ten (10) years after the effective date of this Agreement.

subject matter hereof, and no statements, promises, or inducements made by any Party or agents for any Party that are not contained in this written contract shall be binding or valid and this Agreement may not be enlarged, modified, or altered except in writing, and signed by the Parties.

 It is understood and agreed by the Parties hereto that this Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Utah, the Ordinances of Salt Lake County, and the Murray City Municipal Code, both as to interpretation and performance.






