



- Over 18 years in the Transportation Industry in a variety of Safety/Compliance and Operational management roles.




### **History of CU**

- 1876 CU Founded
- 1950s CU acquired 220 more acres



- 1960s Campus buildings doubled
- 1968 Buff Bus implemented with 1 bus
- 1970s Federal funding increases
- 1990s CU embraces TDM (groups formed)
- 2018 Top 10 institutions (Research, Earth & Environmental Sciences)



### **Sustainability Timeline Highlights**


- 1980s Bicycle Program begins

- 2007 CU signs American College and University President's Climate commitment ("ACUPCC")




#### **Current Milestones**


- 2018 Transportation Master Plan update started
















# SUSTAINABLE TRANSPORTATION : BY THE NUMBERS
