- APTA staff advisor is Jose Reyes



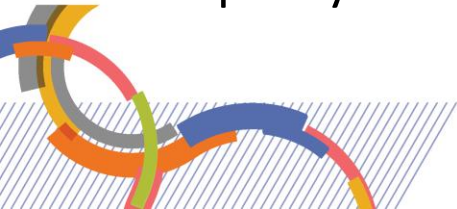
Transit Board Administrators Purpose & Mission
