Dear Members of the Congressional delegation for the National Capital Region:

As Congress works to address the devastating effects of the COVID-19 pandemic, I write to request your urgent assistance to deal with the dire financial circumstances we face as WMATA takes extraordinary steps to protect the health and safety of riders and employees while maintaining essential services for the Nation's Capital.

Metro activated its Pandemic Task Force, guided by the Centers for Disease Control protocols, on January 29, 2020. As of March 13, we are operating at Phase 3 of our Pandemic Flu Plan - the highest level of response - and we expect to be at Phase 3 until further notice.

Today, we began a much reduced, lifeline service to ensure we can protect our frontline employees, while maintaining regional mobility for essential trips taken by hospital staff, local and United States government officials, and emergency responders. The reduction

takes into account the urgent public guidance from regional leaders, along with emergency orders to cancel events, close schools and offices, and limit social gatherings across the nation. We are grateful for the leadership of Governors Hogan and Northam and Mayor Bowser. Our region is speaking with one voice: stay home and travel only if essential.

While all of these steps are critical, they come with high costs. Over the last couple of months, Metro purchased critical items and personal protective equipment (PPE) for front-line employees (i.e. hospital-grade disinfectant, wipes, face masks, gloves, and hand sanitizer) and expanded use of disinfectants for increased cleaning of Metro vehicles and equipment, totaling \$17 million. Today, Metro has lost 85% of its ridership, with limited reduction in operating cost as we continue to provide a vital service for whom public transit is the only means of transportation, as well as our health care workers and first responders. The result of this significant drop in ridership and revenue is that WMATA is experiencing about \$52 million or more each month in revenue loss in addition to increased cost.

Federal assistance is critical to help us offset the direct costs and revenue losses we are facing. We need support for transit operations, but traditional transit formulas are not designed to address our unique circumstances. We need immediate operating funding to address this unprecedented loss of \$52 million a month.

I request your support in securing this emergency funding for WMATA so that we may continue to fulfill our critical role in safely providing lifeline service throughout the National Capital Region.
