 - b. Develop a resource directory of National apprentice programs in the US with successful models and outcomes.
 - c. Develop a best practice guide with templates that can be used by agencies to pilot and implement and pilot.
- 2. Develop a white paper on talent development, staffing, and training requirements for Transit IT departments to assist in upskilling their internal IT departments to meet the immediate challenges they face with advanced systems for infrastructure and zero-emission technology systems.
